ABOUT THE COURSE

This experiential programme is a multidisciplinary approach to the Camino de Santiago through the study of the language, the history, the art, the culture, the gastronomy and the social and economic reality of the Camino.

During the first week you will attend university classes taught by specialists, getting immerse in the traditions and contemporary reality of the Camino.

During the second week, you will have the chance to walk a stretch of the Camino with a teacher of the USC. This journey is divided into 6 stages of 20 km each, average, and it will go through several places of historical and artistic relevance that will serve as a context for the classes on the way.
