ABOUT THE COURSE

The first part of the course provides both a theoretical and practical approach to the most relevant aspects of the language teaching and learning process, focusing on Spanish as a Foreign Language.

It will review basic concepts related to communicative competence as well as other subcompetences, communicative activities and evaluation in the ELE classroom.

It will introduce Spanish learner corpora, analysing their practical applications and go through some of the specific materials used in this area, analysing the possibilities that the new forms of communication offer in the ELE classroom.

It will also review the contribution of the main reference documents in the area of language teaching, namely, the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* and the *Syllabus of the Instituto Cervantes*.

The second part of the course will consist of a series of observation practices in the ELE classroom.
