ABOUT THE COURSE

This course will be a chance for you to improve your Spanish while experiencing the culture of northern Spain with students from your generation sharing your interests. Our small-group classes are designed for students to practice their communicative skills and go through cultural contents related to the Camino de Santiago, Galician gastronomy and wines, art and music.

In the afternoons, students will have a chance to plunge into the local life thanks to our exclusive programme of cultural activities which will allow them to discover the secrets of this age-old city as well as the flavours of its appreciated gastronomy. On the weekends, students may visit the Rías Bajas, in the southern coast of Galicia, with their renowned beaches, coastal villages and towns and their vineyards.
