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PROGRAMS / HIGHLIGHTS

At LCI Barcelona, we believe in offering international students a flexible and enriching educational experience. Therefore, students can mix and match English-taught courses with Spanish language learning courses, tailoring their curriculum to their needs.

Students coming to Study Abroad LCI Barcelona can participate in our exciting programs. We have 12-week semesters (no Spanish visa required) and an 8-week summer session.

We offer various 3 credits and 4 credits courses in the areas of:

- Visual Communication & Design
- Business & Creative Industries
- Art & Society
- Spanish Literature and Linguistics
- Spanish as a Second Language

Students with advanced Spanish proficiency can also take courses with local students during the Spring semester or participate in our three-week intensive summer workshops to explore creative industries disciplines. All workshop courses are taught in Spanish, with local students' participation, and are 4 credits / 60 contact hours.

- We offer support with airport pickup.
